The Department of Biology of Dyson College of Arts and Sciences at Pace University invites applications for two anticipated faculty positions at the Assistant Professor level (tenure track) to begin September 2017. The positions are located on Pace University's Pleasantville, New York campus, which is about 40 miles north of New York City. The Department offers undergraduate degrees in Biology and supports interdisciplinary undergraduate and graduate programs in Environmental Science, as well as Nursing and Health Science programs in association with the College of Health Professions.

Applicants must have an earned PhD or equivalent in Biology or a related field and must have a strong commitment to undergraduate teaching and development of a research program in their specific discipline involving students. Applicants must have expertise in one of the following areas:

Vertebrate Anatomy/Physiology (Position #1)

Teaching responsibilities will focus on Anatomy and Physiology courses to both Nursing students and Biology majors, as well as advanced electives in the candidate's specific field of expertise.

Organismal Biology (Position #2)

Teaching responsibilities will include introductory courses in biology, advanced courses in general organismal biology and in the candidate's specific field of expertise. These may include courses involving study of the structure, function, ecology and evolution at the organismal level, including systems biology.
