ARTICLE II, Connecticut River Estuary Planning Region [Adopted 11-24-1980 by Ord. No. 36 of the 1980 Code]

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§ 48-3. Adoption of statutory provisions and election

The Town of Old Saybrook, being within the Connecticut River Estuary Planning Region, as defined by the Connecticut Development Commission, hereby adopts the provisions of C.G.S. §§ 8-31a to 8-37a, inclusive, and elects to participate in the Connecticut River Estuary Planning Agency, now or henceforth existing under Chapter 127 of the Connecticut General Statutes.

§ 48-4. Appointment of members and term of office. EN

The Board of Selectmen shall appoint one representative and the Planning Commission shall appoint one representative to said Regional Planning Agency, each to serve for a term of two years.

§ 48-5. Vacancies

If a representative should resign or die or be unable to serve, or if he or she is removed from membership, the appointing authority for that representative shall fill the vacancy for the unexpired term.
