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Abstract

This ordinance requires developers to create a drainage report, and describes all that must be included therein. The report must be in accordance with the Town of Brighton Minimum Specifications for Dedication and the Irondequoit Watershed Collaborative.

213-9 Specifications for Preliminary Plats

F. A separate drainage report, including calculations for runoff and pipe and channel sizing, which will clearly indicate the disposal and flood hazard preventions (when necessary) and how all runoff will be handled during grading and development operations, and erosion and sedimentation prevention measures. Design of stormwater mitigation facilities shall be as specified in the Town of Brighton Minimum Specifications for Dedication . and elsewhere in this chapter, and conform to the requirements of the Irondequoit Watershed Collaborative whenever possible and in lieu of employing other methods. **[Amended 6-26-2002 by L.L.
