NOTICE INVITING PUBLIC COMMENT ON
STAFF WHITE PAPER ON BENEFIT-COST ANALYSIS

(Issued July 2, 2015)

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New York State Public Service Commission (Commission) invites comment on the Department of Public Service Staff White Paper on Benefit-Cost Analysis (BCA White Paper), filed July 1, 2015 in the Reforming the Energy Vision (REV) proceeding. The BCA White Paper describes a framework that is intended to be used as a resource to the parties in this proceeding and, in particular, to the state's electric utilities as they prepare their Distributed System Implementation Plans to be filed in 2016.

The full text of the BCA White Paper may be viewed online from the Department's REV webpage, www.dps.ny.gov/REV. The document may also be viewed by entering the case number 14-M-0101 from the Search function on the Department's website (www.dps.ny.gov). Take note, however, that the search function will be temporarily unavailable due to maintenance of the Department's Document and Matter Management system (DMM) between July 3, 2015 at noon and July 6, 2015 at 7 a.m. but the document will still be available from the REV webpage during that time.

Parties may file initial comments by August 14, 2015 and reply comments by September 10, 2015. All comments will become part of the record considered by the Commission. Written comments will be posted for public viewing on the Commission's website. There are several ways to provide your comments to the Commission:

Comments may also be entered directly into the case file by locating the case via the Commission's website, www.dps.ny.gov, by clicking on "Search," and entering "14-M-0101" in the "Search by Case Number" field. Then access the screen to enter comments by clicking on the "Post Comments" box located at the top of the page.

Toll-Free Opinion Line: Individuals may choose to submit comments by calling the Commission's Opinion Line at 1-800-335-2120. This line is set up to receive in-state calls 24-hours a day. These calls are not transcribed but a summary is reported to the Commission.
