The Film and Screen Studies Department within the Dyson College of Arts and Sciences at Pace University invites applications for two anticipated faculty positions at the Assistant Professor level (tenure track) to begin September 2020. The positions are located at the University's New York City campus in lower Manhattan.

Applicants should have an earned PhD or equivalent in the critical study of film and screen media. We are primarily interested in applicants whose expertise is in one or more of the following specific areas: African-American cinema/media histories and cultural formations; critical media studies with a focus on race and ethnicity; global cinema in an American context; "Third Cinemas"; television studies, web-based video cultures and/or media convergence. Candidates must show a strong commitment to undergraduate education and are expected to teach both introductory and advanced courses on cinematic histories and theories along with developing new courses in their areas of expertise.

The Film and Screen Studies Department is focused on the ethics and social impact of media culture, and is thus committed to developing a more inclusive and equitable campus community. Candidates who have experience working with a diverse range of faculty, staff and students and who can contribute to the climate of inclusivity are encouraged to identify their experiences in these areas.
